Bible Society News

The Bible is coming to life for thousands of First Nations people through a new app in one of Australia's most used Indigenous languages, Pitjantjatjara.

Bible Society Australia's translator and engagement co-ordinator says "It's going to be a great literacy aid. If people don't know how to read Pitjantjatjara, they can follow along on the app and hear the Scriptures being read aloud. The other day I was helping a lady renew her driver's licence. There was a long queue, so while we were waiting we were listening to the Scripture on her phone. Then another Pitjantjatjara lady came in, and she couldn't believe the first lady could hear this on her phone. We installed the app on her phone too. She said she would go home and put it on her son's phone. Word spreads very quickly."

Pray for many to hear the Gospel with this technology.


King of the ages, almighty God ...
