Jimmy and Carol Owens wrote and staged Christian musicals. As a teenager she performed on several of her parents' albums, which made her a star in the Jesus music movement.



**Keith Gordon Green** (1953–1982)

was born into musical talent. His maternal grandfather was a songwriter and his mother

studied voice at Carnegie Hall. By five years old, Green played the ukulele and began formal

music lessons. He was writing his own music by age 9. When he died in a plane crash on July 28 1982, the world lost a special man whose heart was aflame

with the gospel message. Before his untimely end, Green took the world on his seven-year spiritual journey. He held back nothing and was consumed with loving Christ and the church.
